When I started writing stories I used a pen and paper exclusively. Then I was given a typewriter, which I used for several years, but I still wrote by hand first and typed up the work later. After that I acquired a computer and began writing directly onto the screen; I occasionally would write a story by hand anyway, and I still do this, simply because the rhythms of composition are different.

Thus I have many manuscripts available that I am willing to give away as small 'gifts' to readers. Most of these manuscripts are stories that have been published in various places. Some are poems, sketches and articles. There are also a few drawings of very dubious quality. To round off the selection of material I have included some rare chapbooks. There are 71 items in total.
